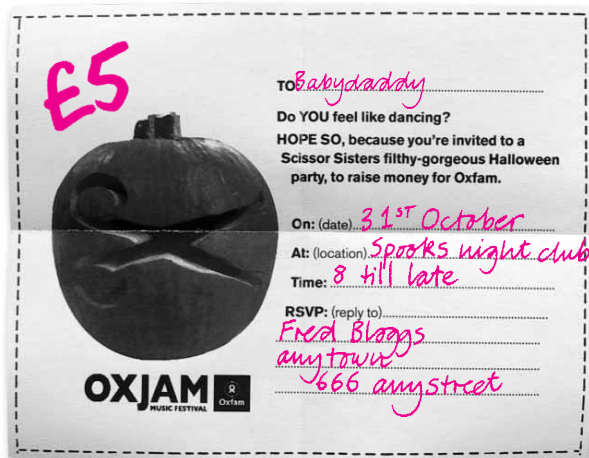
Everything you need for a splendid show.

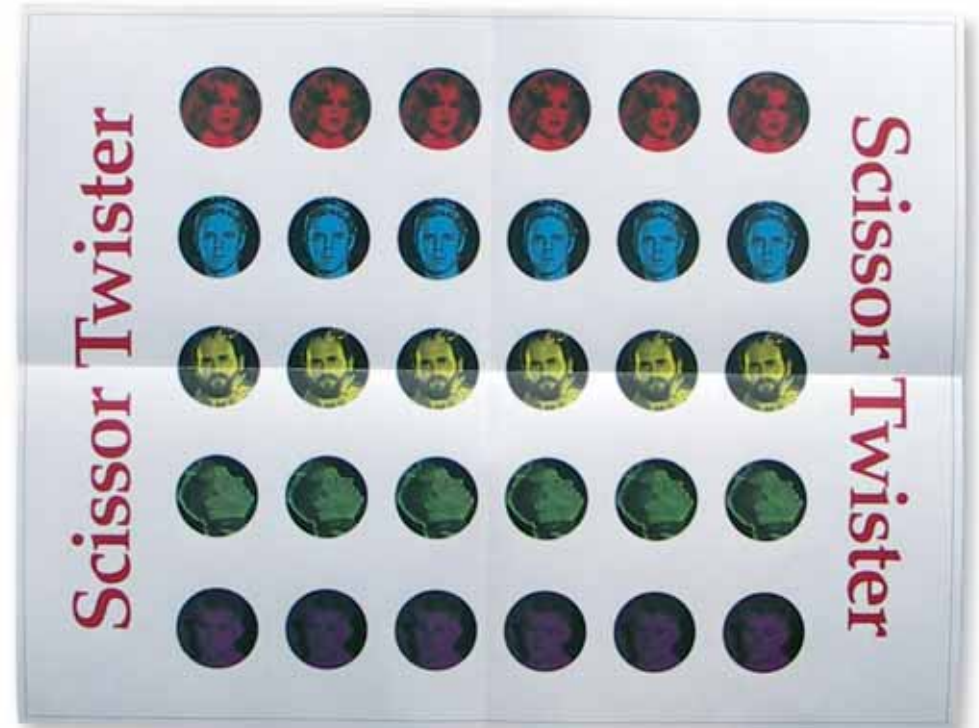

Mix and match some of these ideas to raise money while entertaining your guests.

- Collect donations on the door
- Charge for tickets/entry
- Make and sell special Scissor-licious cocktails (see Riotous recipes for creepy cocktails p5)
- Hold an auction. Know someone who could 'donate' a singing lesson? Or cook up a romantic dinner for two? Get your friends to donate their talents as prizes, then auction them off to the highest bidders! All of the money goes to Oxfam.

Party games

- Play Scissor Sisters Twister: you know the game – just adapt the floor mats to give them a Halloween/Sisters theme.
- Make a 'tail' and use a large pic of Jake (or whoever else you'd like to see with a tail!) to make a 'pin the tail on' contest! Blindfold your guests and charge them per 'go'.
- Charge guests to enter your Best Costume competition.
- Charge guests to enter a 'Dead Rock Stars' talent show – they dress up and perform those 'raves from the grave' by stars no longer with us.

Show off your creative flare by making your party place look like a palace.

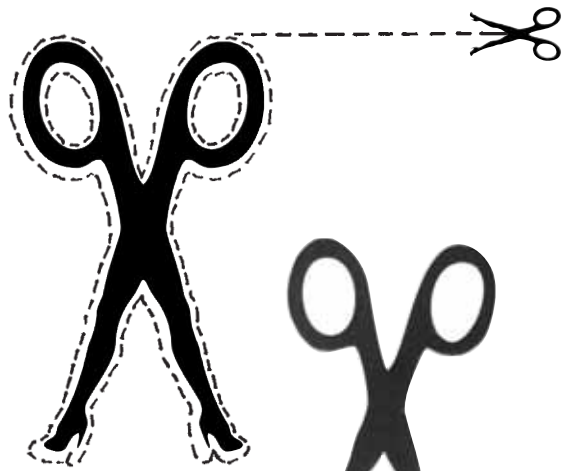


Cutting a dash...

Riotous recipes for creepy cocktails

A good host looks after their guest Sisters with plenty of hospitality. Here are a couple of specially selected Scissor-licious recipes for you to try.

Fairtrade Thriller Cocktail

- 25ml Havana Club Rum
- Dash Benedictine Liqueur
- 1/3 glass of Fairtrade Fruit Passion Pure Tropical Juice
- Top-up with soda water. Shake with ice and serve decorated with Scissors swizzle sticks and other creepy decorations!

Dirty Fairtrade dish water (Non-alcoholic)

- One part Fairtrade orange juice
- One part lemonade
- One part cola
- Mix together and enjoy!

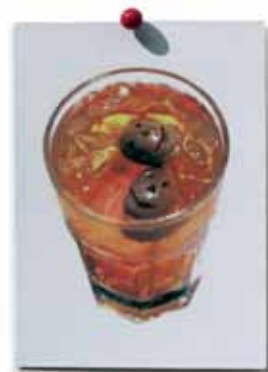
Glam up your party drinks!
